



Winter Activities

Skiing and Snowboarding

Aspen Snowmass offers four distinct mountains—Snowmass, Aspen Mountain, Aspen Highlands, and Buttermilk—each with unique terrain. Snowmass is the largest, ideal for all levels, while Aspen Highlands is known for expert terrain like Highland Bowl. Buttermilk is beginner-friendly and hosts the Winter X Games. Aspen Mountain caters to intermediate and advanced skiers with stunning views and direct access from downtown Aspen.

Tubing

Located at Elk Camp in Snowmass, the tubing hill features multiple lift-served lanes and is open daily during ski season. It's a fun, family-friendly activity. Tubing opens 12/19 and is subject to availability and appropriate weather conditions.

Snowshoeing

Guided snowshoe tours are offered through the Aspen Center for Environmental Studies. These tours weave through serene forests and offer educational insights into local ecology. Trails are also available for self-guided exploration.

Ice Skating

Enjoy outdoor skating at the Snowmass Base Village Plaza or Silver Circle Ice Rink in Aspen. Indoor options include the Aspen Ice Garden and Lewis Ice Arena. Rentals are available, and some rinks offer lessons and drop-in hockey.

Cross Country Skiing

Aspen and Snowmass feature over 90 km of groomed Nordic trails. The Aspen Cross Country Center offers rentals, lessons, and guided tours. Trails wind through scenic landscapes with views of the Elk Mountains.
